I had worked voluntarily for the area studies of Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation during the foundation period of it in 2002. We had opportunities to meet with many young people and children during these studies. There weren't only children of course. And also their fathers who weren't be able to do something and their mothers who wanted to change a little bit the lives of their daughters...

Especially the young people... they hadn't any thing to do but only the fixed difficult working conditions and most of them had to earn many by working at the textile ateliers to earn the money for their families who were in difficult conditions. Some of the young people had left their school or some of them hadn't even gone to school. They only had to find a job at the small textile ateliers near their house with their unqualified condition. They tried to find their lost lives as working uninsured in the difficult conditions with the low price and big hopes. They were working 7 days in a week and 1012 hours in a day, but they couldn't take their money or they were taking the minimum wage in return of their great efforts. Sometimes they weren't paid. Then they only had to change their jobs with a great hatred.

In this case, many years would pass until these people who were tried to be the others-get the necessary experience for their works and their lives. This youngs who hadn't any education from anywhere had to be supported and they had to be gained for the society. We had observed all of these and we were discussion the possible solutions and remedies. At that time, the applications for the donation projects of ÝPKUR, at the coverage of "The New Opportunities Program" which was supported by EU and aiming to create the effective employment policies were accepted.

Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation was aware of his mission. We applied for it.

Maybe the number of the people who take the advantages of the Project seems insufficient to you, but we saw the wave of the joy between those people. Each of them were effecting the two other people. We had only thrown a small pebble into the sea of the problems and the wave of our stone was getting bigger day by day...

This book is the product of that kind of studies. When reading this book and looking the drawings, don't forget that every drawing has its own story. You will see the pictures of the owner of these stories. You will also find the studies of realized and shared with joy, hope, love by 55 persons in a small education workshop at one of the ghettos of the mega city Ýstanbul, with project workers, educators and volunteers during one year.

Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation don't only express itself but it also touches and applies. We were also surprised with their families at the end of the each semester because of the results which were created by these small groups.

I would like to express my sincere thanks to the Project team which has many great efforts in this Project not only as the workers but also as semi-volunteers, to President of Foundation, especially to our instructors who have given the artistic courses, but mostly I would like to thank to the young students who have a huge heart and sticked to the urban life and fought with its difficult conditions as a rural flower against the power of the wind.

INTRODUCTION

During the formation phase of the foundation, we started the area studies aiming to specify kind of the services mostly needed by the people living in the region and to detect the most intensive problems.

We were face to face with an immigration event during the area studies. Families which have come to Ystanbul due to "Compulsory immigration" had many psychological-social problems, cultural problems, health problems and economic difficulties e.t.c.

In January 2005, we aimed to get professional skills by the Project for the young people between 1830 age who had experienced the compulsory immigration and dwelling in Kadýköy, Kartal, Maltepe, Beykoz, Üsküdar, Tuzla, Pendik, Ümraniye and Sultanbeyli districts of Anatolian (Asia Minor) side of Ýstanbul. Because the young people who were unqualified and experienced the difficulties of the compulsory immigration had to work at the ateliers which were near to them and were paying the lowest (minimum wage) price and they had to wait for many years to be qualified persons.

When starting to the studies, there were many data about the target group because of the previously executed project (Ses-Çýk-Give A Sound Project). The important thing was to reveal and make vital those data. Even though it was an employment Project which was supported by EU and executed by Ýpkur, we didn't want that the project shouldn't have been remained only as a vocational and employment project, due to the target group. You will see after reading of this book which contains the results of the Project that those studies were not only vocational course but at the same time it was a social Project

As Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation we detected the necessities of the target group and then we started the studies with our project partner Amargi Women Solidarity Cooperation. Especially it was a necessity to start the studies with the most disadvantageous group of women. Both studies of our foundation at sexual equality issue and the status of our partner as being women cooperation made us to take many steps.

While specifying our target group, we made a positive discrimination between the women and illiterate people. We took the illiterate people to the completing (workshop) section. A short time was enough for the people who would be trained as completing workers (persons who are able to use some of the machines) for the related sectors. While we were giving the lessons, we gave the vocational education for two days in a week and also two days for reading/writing course in a week. Those young people while getting reading/writing skills, also got the professional skills for the related jobs at the sector.

There were also cutting, modelist and stylist sections beside the completing section. Also while giving the vocational education four days a week at these sections; we were also giving the social education lessons one day in a week to all of the students. We all together went to the picnic and cinema. Whereas, these activities (picnic and cinema) weren't planned in the Project. Only the trips related to the sectors could be realized at the coverage of the project. At that point, the foundation was presenting all of its facilities and possibilities. Also Computer course was one of these opportunities. 15 of these people who were taking the advantages of the Project completed computer course.

We gave the consultation service to students and their families in connection

with their demands and necessities. We organized seminars related to communication between the family members. At the coverage of the training period, we sent our students to know the business places and textile factories which are outside of the workshops, to be familiar with the sector and to practice the theory.

Our target group was the young people who have experienced the difficulties of the compulsory immigration. Specialists state that an compulsory immigration would cause the social and traumatic problems. In this case, the economical indefiniteness, lack of receiving of the basic necessities (education, health e.t.c.) would cause the break down of the social structure. For that reason, we tried to educate those young people with the art to be in harmony with the big city and we diverted to them diverted to the various artistic courses of the Foundation.



CHAPTER 1 DETECTION OF THE GENERAL STATUS AND THE **PROBLEMS**

Definition of The Compulsory Immigration

Immigration: It is defined as the movement of the population from a settling place to another settling place. The immigration term in general is: Changing of the living place individually or collectively by force or as voluntarily.

According to Hillmann's definition "Immigration means living of the people from their original geography and socio-culture and resettle in a country or region to which one is not native and has a different geography and socioculture. In terms of their characteristics, there are many type of immigrations such as; domestic immigration, external immigration, voluntary and compulsory immigration or continual immigration." (Hillmann, K.H.(1994), Akt.Durugönül(1997), II.National Sociology Congress-Society and Ýmmigration, s 95, D. Ý. E Press)

"According to the studies of specialist and academicians members from TESEV Domestic Compulsory Immigration Research and Observing Group; (TESEV Ülke Ýçinde Yerinden Edilme Araþtýrma ve Ýzleme Grubu), "Without any demand from the people or the families; an compulsory immigration without any during the years 1984-1999 of disputes has taken place in the East and South Anatolia regions of Turkey. The problems related to social status, economical status, political status, legal status, psychological situation and health situation causing from the compulsory immigration of thousands of the people still continue even many years have passed. The definition which was constituted according to literature of refugees and human rights law and humanity law and accepted by the international communities has taken place

in The Leading Principles United Nations Related "To Compulsory Immigration in the Country". According to this, "people or group who are forced to leave their original places in domestic due to force or compulsory causing from the effects of armed conflict, from the violations in general, from the violations of the human rights or from the effects of the natural disasters; are called as ÜYEK (Persons who are compulsory immigrants)

The Studies Carried Out At Some Areas

The Studies Carried Out At Some Areas

At the project Ses Çýk (Don't Bother Just Support It) previously carried out by Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation, it was carried out an area study in connection with the people who have come due to compulsory immigration and settled in nine (9) counties of Anatolia (Asia Minor) side of Istanbul. The

negotiations with 500 families who have come due to the compulsory immigration have been realized during this study.

At the study which has been realized among 13- 18 age group children,19 -25 age group young people and 26-35 age group of people; the research data related to adaptation to urban life with the compulsory immigration experience, related to sociological-economical, psychological problems, physical-mental diseases and their effects on education e.t.c. issues have been evaluated.

According to researches of Ses Çýk (Don't Bother Just Support It); the negotiations carried out with 588 young people belong to 19-25 age group has shown important things related to education. It was detected that %20.4 of them haven't registered for any school, %13.3 of them have been registered to primary school but couldn't complete it, %38.3 of them are graduated from primary school, %3.9 of them have left the middle high school, %1.8 of them has started to high school but haven't completed, %7 of them are graduated from high school, and only %2.5 of them in this group have been registered to university education or have completed university education.

"The education has also shown some differences between women and men." The education rates between the girls are low. Some of them have never been registered to any school, and the other girls who have started to the school couldn't have completed their education because of the economical, social, psychological, cultural problems and the difference between the education methods and the other problems such as adaptation problems e.t.c. The education level of 76% of this group is at primary school or under the primary school level.

It is seen that the unemployment rate of this group is very high. 55.1 % of 458 persons belong to 19-25 age group have a job, but %37.2 of them haven't any job. When scrutinizing the employment statistics of these workers, it can be seen that the confection (textile) sector has the biggest portion and it can be also seen that this rate is very high among the women (%81.9).

Because of the textile ateliers being beside the settlement of these families, being familiar with the owners of the ateliers, lack of the job opportunities for this group due to unqualified and uneducated status; families prefer to make their sons and daughters work at those textile ateliers. The most general feature of these ateliers is (physical conditions, health conditions, social relations e.t.c.) the lacking of quality and social security and the place of them at the counties which have the low socio-economic conditions. At the same time, the children and young people who have experienced the difficult effects of compulsory immigration and suffering from the lack of social life; prefer to work at this kind of textile ateliers also for communication with their equals. Even though they are not satisfied with the bad conditions of those textile ateliers, those ateliers seem as the only choice for this group.

Being as the near to them, those textile ateliers are preferred and the families think that they have chance to inspect their children, also families think that this situation is more "reliable" than other type of jobs, and the reasons such as working of the young girls at those ateliers, working of twothree siblings at the same textile ateliers make those kind of jobs preferable for families."

CHAPTER II PROJECT EXECUTORS

Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation ("The Executor")

The leader executor of EMEK Project is Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation. All of the studies were executed at the responsibility of the Foundation. The foundation was established in 2002 in at Kayýþdaðý quarter of Kadýköy county in Ýstanbul, taking into consideration the opportunity equalities by a group of profession members (social service specialist, psychologist, nurse, pedagogue and educators) after the area studies carried out with children and young people who were working.

Its Aim; To reveal, urge, support, improve, the artistic abilities of the poor and destitute children and young people, to remove the obstacles which lacks the personal development, to divert the young people to the production sector as the healthy individuals for the benefit of the society, to provide the self-confidence and satisfaction for themselves, to improve their skills to solve the problems.

TARGET GROUP

- Poor and destitute children and young people,
- Children and young people who have been compulsory immigrated, have left their schools and working,
- The children and young people who have been compulsory immigrated and marginalized in terms of social and cultural effects,
- The children and young people who are under the risk (who are having the violence in the family, who have drug addiction, who have left their home, who have attitude disorders e.t.c.),
- Women

The basic principles of the studies are making the children and young people to express themselves and take place in the everyday life, to know each other without alienation, to establish empathy, to trust each other by the artistic




and cultural activities There are educational courses beside the other artistic courses such as theatre (Creative Drama, Pantomime), folk dances, modern dance, ceramics, painting, solmization, baðlama (a musical instrument), guitar. There are also computer sciences, math, English, reading/writing courses. The courses are given as free of charge by the volunteer artists and educators. Also the scholarships are given to every students beginning from the students of primary school to university students. The women have 70 %of the priority at all of the courses and studies.

In terms of human psychology and social adaptation, it is an important necessity that the human being has to adapt the conditions of his living place. Babak Cultural and Artistic Foundation provide psycho-social support by the various program and projects and also continue to the consciousness raising studies.

Executing Projects:

Don't Bother, Just Support It (Ses Çýk), Getting Job By Vocational Course EMEK, The Children Will Come With Art, Illiterateness Is The Deepest Well-The Knowledge Is A Window To The Life, To The Healthy Tomorrows With The Young People.

During our activities we try to improve solidarity and dialog with the domestic and foreign institutions at the base of cooperation, we cooperate with various



governmental foundation/institutions, NGO, local administration and unions in domestic and also cooperate with universities and academicians to support the scientific studies and to support the production of the scientific data. Also we present support to doctorate students during their studies and training period both in domestic and at abroad related to the target group.

In this respect, the necessary support related to their area studies was presented to an academician from Anthropology Department of Oslo University in Sweden, to a doctorate student from Social Science Institute of Marmara University and also to some of the students who continue to their doctorate studies in Germany and they were invited to start their training period at projects.



AMARGÝ Women Solidarity Cooperation (Project Partner)



Amargi is a kind of the women organization which was established in June 2001 by the women who had the similar imagination. With our organization power continuing in Adana and Antakya, we came together to announce women problems in the streets also.

One of the most important reasons of establishing of Amargi is, to constitute a philosophic background at language, art, history, science, politics and in ourselves; at the base of questioning the patriarchal system which is seen at every stage of the life, and to develop and strength the feminist ideology and philosophy. The main aim is to produce permanent and concrete solutions for women problems at the light of philosophy.

Without any hierarchic priority, we would like to reveal the hidden conflicts to realize the projects which will remove the obstacles in front of the social change.

We organize seminars, meetings, some discussions related to articles and books, some exercises related to remove the violence, theatric discussion programs and local meetings e.t.c. related to our concrete problems and theory issues.

We carry out our studies to generalize the women liberation movement at every area of the women such as at home, street, kitchen, school, business place, dormitories, factories, organizations and political parties.

Amargi is a kind of women organization which targets to reach all of the women of the society. We, as the women in the society such as women workers, women officials, unemployed women, students, housewives, sex workers, lesbians, transsexuals and the women from some ethnical groups in the society are all together. As we question the power relations in the society, all of the women in the society are the target group of Amargi. There are many women from every sections of society since four years and we continuously try to organize the women from the other different sections of society.

Since the life experiences of the different people strength our activities and feminist theory, we can describe the activity itself as our consultant. Our main motto from the beginning till today is Living is the most important academic activity.

Our lives are surrounded by the ideologies which constantly produce violence such as sexism, capitalism, militarism, racism, heterosexism, age discrimination. These understandings cause to be despised and isolated of the women and cause to be exposed to sexual, physical, psychological, economic violence of women. The heavy conditions of our problems and their position as putting the women against each other, make our studies and organization more difficult. At this point, Amargi tries to guest all of the problems of the women at the base of philosophy and ideology and also presents the educational, cultural and artistic productions related to questioning and overcoming of the power relations in society

For that reason, EMEK Project is very important for us-women from Amargi organization- to meet with the new experiences and develop the new policies with those experiences. EMEK Project has thought many things to the women of Amargi organization in terms of describing the problems, developing solidarity and meeting with the new life experiences of the women who work at textile sector.



CHAPTER III **EMEK PROJECT**

a) The Aim

EMEK Project which was executed by the leader Babak Cultural and Artistic Foundation and its partner Amargi Women Solidarity Cooperation is related to the young people who have suffered from the bad effects of compulsory immigration and settling in Asian side of Istanbul. It was offered that 50 people as 35 women and 15 men would take the advantages of the Project. While executing the Project, this amount has increased to 55 people because of the claims. By this Project which made contributions for the related section, has educated the persons who were unqualified and uneducated as completing worker, cutting worker, modelist and stylist at textile sector. This vocational education has been supported by social education such as improving the personality, solutions for adaptation problems, self-confidence and human rights and liberties. 20 persons of the students were stated from the illiterate section and these people have taken reading/writing course.

At the end of the course, %40 of the persons has been employed by the activities of the sectorial consultant.



The Project constitutes from two main sections.

- 1) Vocational courses (completing, cutting, modelist and stylist courses)
- 2) Social educations

b) Targets of the Project

- To educate 50 of young people who are between 18-30 age group and have come by compulsory immigration and settling at Asian side of Istanbul for completing, cutting, modelist and stylist areas.
- First of all to educate 20 persons who are illiterate and to make them qualified people for various works.
- To make the related group familiar with the local textile market for employment facilities.
- To divert them to the business places, to increase the skills related to job interviews.
- To constitute the personal improvement, social responsibilities, social rights awareness, sexual awareness of the related group.
- Sharing of the necessary information related to this issue and to support them with the social education to increase the awareness related to their rights.
- According to positive discrimination principle of the foundation; to allocate %70 of the quota for the women.
- To increase the qualified young population to prevent child worker status.
- To attract attention of NGOs, public and private sector to the compulsory immigration; to constitute a model for solutions at the coverage of communication and cooperation.

c) Target Group (Terms)

1-Being a person suffering from compulsory immigration,

- 2-Being a poor and destitute person,
- 3- Being at the age of 18 by the end of the course (The people who work at this sector are generally at the middle school age. We saw by area studies that there is more demand for the persons under 18).

- 4- Being under age 30,
- 5- Presence of 20 illiterate people,
- 6- Being as unemployed person,
- 7- Being as an unqualified person,
- 8- Being settled at Anatolia side of Istanbul, According to the positive discrimination principle of the foundation, women have application priorities at all of the departments of the Foundation.

d) The problems detected and their solutions

- *20 people who haven't reading/writing skills have learned reading/writing.
- * 55 qualified persons were educated working at textile sector.
- * 55 students have got the new skills by vocational and social education;

they have also learned to apply for a job and learned the successful interview method techniques and job applications.

- * Employment of them has been facilitated by the new skills they gained.
- * They have got the experience by additional computer course related to technical skills and so they have increased their chance to find a job.
- * Textile sector has got chance by these projects to obtain directly the qualified employees. The low production rate which has been continued for many years has been prevented by projects.
- * The consultation service aiming to provide psychological support was given to 42 students.
- * The personal consultation service has been given to them as improving their social skills and breaking the social isolations they have improved, to make them get the information related to using the facilities of the sources of the city.
- * They have adaptation problems and psychological-social problems due to the socio-economic differences. So they were diverted to the artistic courses of the foundation and they have gained adaptation via art.
- * Meetings related to boosting of consciousness of the families were realized and they have been informed related to the importance of education, communication skills and sexual discrimination.
- * The families who have expressed that they had to make their children to work, have been informed about the most suitable works.
- * As being a non-governmental organization, there have been some contributions related to sexual equality in the society. Activities have been carried out for benefits of the women who present the disadvantageous side of the society.
- * By social education, personal improvement and individual consultation service;
- The necessary service related to psycho-social support have been given to the young people who have been neglected and experienced compulsory immigration, by this way, they have gained their self-confidence again.
- It has been observed that students have improved the new solutions for their social and cultural adaptation problems.
- They have improved the self-confidence which will divert them related to their future.
- -They have learned to control their anger.
- -They have improved some skills against the problems.
- -They are more hopeful for their future.
- * By the introduction meetings realized at the end of the Project; attention of the related institutions/corporations, local administrations, universities, job finding institutions, media and women organizations.

COURSES

Vacational Courses

Vocational courses have been arranged and given 4 days a week. The courses are consisted from two periods each contains five months.

Completing training, cutting training and modelist course have been during the first period. 23 students are graduated from the courses at the end of this period.

Completing, cutting and stylist courses have been given at the second period. Upon the intensive demands, 32 students have been accepted to this education period which lasted five months. Totally 55 persons have taken the advantages of the Project. The education materials, meal and transportation service of the students have been provided. Also students have been supported with 8 Euro pocket money per day.

It was observed that students have some adaptation problems with city, some psycho-social problems; and for that reason, the psychological support and personal consultation have been provided for them. The students are educated to obtain the personal awareness during the psycho-social service. By this support, the skills of the students have been revealed and they have obtained the self-confidence. The students have been diverted to various artistic courses of the foundation. Some of the students, who haven't found a chance previously to reveal their various skills, are still continuing to the courses after completing of Emek project.

a) Completing Section

It presents completing training and reading/writing education beside the social education and it was organized to shorten the long working conditions which last for many years for the unqualified young people whose age group is 18-30 and have experienced the difficult effects of the compulsory immigration.



It was given to totally 22 students in 5 months both theoretically and practically and lasted during the two periods as 2 days in a week And also the positive discrimination principle of the foundation has been applied for women who are disadvantageous in the target group and 17 women, 4 men have taken the advantages of this course, also 20 of them have been selected from the illiterate people. While the students of this section were taking vocational education 2 days in a week, those illiterate people have also There will be 10 trained and reading/writing course 2 days in a week and social education one day in a week qualified cutters - 5 persons for each term- at the end of the Project. The cutting training will be given 4 days in a week. The practical part of the total education will be given at workshop and the theoretical part of it will be given at class

They have also taken the common courses related to ironing and cutting issues and general information about the sector with the students of stylist and cutting section.



b) Cutting Section

The cutting training has been given as theoretically and practically 4 days in a week and also social education has been given as one day in a week. 10 students who were consisting of 6 women and 4 men have been educated during two education periods each contained 5 months.

The students at the cutting section also has taken completing education.

While the students of completing section were taking reading/writing course, students of cutting section were taking practical machine and ironing training on the same day. The common courses related to sector have been given with modelists and stylists.

Students also have been diverted to the artistic courses of the foundation, they also have taken advantages of the free computer course of the foundation.

c) Modelist Training:

Students of modelist course have taken five days of education as vocational education 4 days in a week and social education one day in a week. The



course has continued during five months. The students of this course were selected among the people who were graduated from primary schools. Totally 10 people have finished the courses.

The practical courses have been given. Model drawing and practical studies were carried out.

These students also have been diverted to the artistic courses of the foundation and they have taken the advantages of computer course of the foundation.

d) Stylist Trainning

As it was planned to educate only 10 students at the beginning of the Project, 4 more students have been added at this period due to intensive demand. 13 women and 1 man, tolatly 14 students have taken the education. They have taken stylist education 4 days in a week and social education as one day in a week. The general knowledge related to sector have been taken with all of other departments. Also while the students of the completing section were taking reading/writing course, the students of stylist course have taken the practical machine lessons.

Computer Department

Computer course is actually not at the coverage of the Project, but it has been presented as freely for students as a free support education.

Totally 15 persons have taken the advantages of computer course which lasted two periods during three and half a month.

2 men and 13 women students have completed computer course.

The priority was given to the women who are the most disadvantageous section and the students who were graduated from primary school.

SOCIAL EDUCATIONS

Social Education Issues

The problems related to human rights, women rights and health e.t.c. due to uneducated and unqualified status and awareness of them for their rights and responsibilities. Consciousness-raising related to social communication, individuality, getting of the skills to overcome the problems, self-confidence, using of official places, job finding techniques e.t.c. The social education lesson have been given one day in a week related to removing of externalization feelings, getting of belonging feelings, getting of the awareness feeling. The social education issues have been specified as taking into consideration the problems of the students and this lesson has been given by the specialists of the subject.

Some supportive educations by the foundation have been given to the students which were specified according to the results of the social education and also according to the necessities of the students. The support educations are as following:

a) Individual Consultation

Various attitudes at the society, confidence, developing the self confidence and communication issues have been processed during three days in a week. The target group has been informed related to having the common using areas with the urban people, to make some changes at their conditions and living places, to get awareness feeling, to develop their social skills and break their isolation, to use the sources surrounding them and they have been diverted to use the facilities of the city. 5 persons have been diverted to Open University.

b) Personal Development

The personal development lessons have been given by a volunteer of the foundation as 2 hours in a week. The studies which aimed to make the members of the group more critical, more questioning the issues or being awareness of the responsibilities have been carried out.

c) Social Activities

As aiming to make the students see the different places of the city and covering the social rules related to the city; they have been taken to picnic, cinema and the other places which contain the vocational places (fabric receiving e.t.c.).

Beside the social education and activities; the students have taken the active roles in artistic and cultural activities and they were made to develop the self skills to overcome the various problems.

CONSULTATION and DIVERTION SERVICES

- a) Psychological
- b) Individual negotiation
- c) Family negotiations

a) Individual negotiation

According to their demands, consultation and guidance services were given by psychologist and social service specialist to the students who were continuing to the course. These persons have been diverted to various artistic courses of the foundation and necessary places.

b) Group studies


Group studies at communication and urban life adaptation issues were realized according to type of the problems of students. The groups were consisted from 8-12 persons. Group studies have continued until end of the course. It was observed that the problems of the students have been gradually reduced.

c) Family negotiations

Negotiations with the families of the students were realized before the course activities, and the appropriate families and persons have been detected. As we think that the family structure is very important for personal development; the families were also added to the education process. Family negotiations related to disputes happening among the members of the family, communication problems and family structure were realized.

ARTISTIC COURSES

While taking the vocational education, the students have been diverted to various artistic courses of the foundation as revealing the artistic skills inside of them and overcoming of the difficulties easily in their lives. 45 students out of 55 have taken the advantages of artistic courses. Students have attended to music (Chorus), folklore activities (folk dance) and theatre workshops. They have presented shows at the end of two introduction periods.



CHAPTER IV **EVALUATIONS**

- a) Opinions of the Specialists and Educators related to Project and students
- b) Opinions of the students (course takers) (Their Evaluations)

OPINIONS OF THE SPECIALISTS AND EDUCATORS

Psychologist : Oya ÇELÝK (Emek Project- Psychological Consultation)

During the months November and December, I made negotiations with 26 women and 6 men out of 32 young people from "Emek Project" whose age group was between 18-29. The detailed sexual segmentation of those women and men was detected as following; 17 women and 3 men at 18-20 age interval, 5 women and 1 man at 21-23 age interval, 4 women and 2 men at 26-29 age interval. The negotiations were arranged as 40-50 intervals according to necessities of the young people. After completing of the negotiations with all of 32 young people, I negotiated two more times with 8 young people and three times with 1 young people upon their request.

The reason for the second negotiations of the young people upon their request was related to Project which would be finished. I observed an anxiety and confusion between those young people in connection with the project. The reason for high level anxiety of them was that they thought that they wouldn't get such a chance and atmosphere again. Those young people were anxious about the coming years, job searching and working conditions after the project. During the second negotiation, I detected that many problems of those young people had been gradually reduced. I thought that the lessons such as "Communication" taken during the Project, caused the big effects and helped them to reduce their problems. I also can say that the effects of their positive behaviors as an individual in the same group and sharing feelings have the big roles for these problems and reduced the problems. As knowing the other people during the Project who have the similar problems, and presence of the people who have listened, understood their problems also helped them to feel themselves as worthy persons and those factors have helped them to correct themselves.

25 of the young people coming to negotiations were from the east of Turkey and have immigrated to Istanbul with their families, 7 of them were from Istanbul but their families have immigrated to Istanbul many years ago. Most of them belonged to the crowded families and all of them were having the economical limitations. Those young people had left their school or never registered any school. But some of them considered completing their education via open education facilities.

Most of the young people whom I negotiated with during the Project had some problems with their families. The most important problem among those was the conflict between them and their families. The main reason of the conflict between the young girls and their families was the oppression of their families. There were some young people who expressed that they hadn't any problem and conflict with their families. But according to my observations, those young people were also under dominating control of their families.

When scrutinizing on those young people from the in general manner, we can see that one of the biggest problems is suicide thought of those people. Most of the young people have expressed that they are so sensitive and

bored and got angry very quickly, they dwell upon the subjects during a long time and they got angry quickly against every events. Because of the intensive aggression seen among the young people, some of the young people have applied violence against their family members or their friends.

Some of the young people, who expressed their thoughts about the adaptation to Istanbul, have told that they have some problems. The biggest difficulties related to the adaptation are; externalization feeling from the society, alienation feeling in the society and the language problems of the people who could speak only Kurdish. These difficulties related to adaptation causes the problems among the young people such as uneasiness, antagonism, panic, emotional non-reacting status. Beside these problems also the other problems such as insomnia, absent-mindness, and headache are also seen among those young people.

While 90% of those young people are willing to speak at the coverage of the consultation, 10% of them avoided to reflect their problems during the negotiations. Most of the people who came to the negotiations expressed that the Project was very good and beneficial for them and expressed their sorrows because the Project would come a conclusion. One of the most important reasons which effected this situation-as stated above- is meeting of them at a different atmosphere because of escaping from family problems and the other reason is meeting with the other people who have listened their problems and showed respect for them. Those young people maybe felt the first time that they were understood in their life.

Educator : Pýnar ÖNEN Specialist Psychologist (Medical School of Kocaeli University, Psychiatry Main Department-Mental Trauma Center)

I have given 2 social education lessons to the participators of the project at the coverage of Emek Project which executed by Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation. The subject of the first social education was knowledge related to the general mental health and the information related to overcome the stress. The subject of the second social education was expressing of the feelings and thoughts, communication skills, self-confidence, finding solutions to problems. The participations to the education were full and it lasted whole day. The education was carried out in interactive mode. The participators were urged to share their experiences and feelings. The education was enriched by the various games.

It was observed that the participators were motivated as they were supporting themselves during the educations. They have also expressed at the feedbacks at the end of the education that they were satisfied from the education. I had chance to observe the group during two education days. I observed that most of the participators had psycho-sociologic difficulties and psychological problems. 30 or 40% of the group members had mental problems which required the psychiatric treatment. This group needed to be treated during a long time. The other members of the group had some psychological difficulties at some areas. It was observed that the group had two main psycho-sociologic features. Lack of self-expression, lack of confidence, social anxiety and performance anxiety problems were observed at the first group. This group was listening to the lesson carefully but was showing the resistance to the active participation and had lack of expression during the education. The second group was had some problems related to motivation, anger control, social relations and adaptation. Some of them had potential to show the risky behaviors. This group were attending to the education intensively, but sometimes showed some

behaviors which broke the flow of the education down. Consequently, it was thought that the whole group needed to take the intensive psycho-social support programs during a long time. It was also thought that the group which had introvert features and lack of self-confidence should have taken the advantages of the small group studies. The necessity of the social education for such disadvantageous groups which had psycho-social difficulties was observed also for those participators. It was thought that such groups which hadn't any social or health insurances and hadn't any chance to take the advantages of a long timed treatment in the hospital, would be supported with such type of supportive programs. Since the group studies are designed as more economical and interactive format, it is a very appropriate and therapeutic intervention especially for the disadvantageous groups. It is very important to support the young people, in terms of psycho-social development who were educated and qualified and got the job at the coverage of Emek Project. Because the person is a whole consisted from the physical, mental, social and cultural features. It would not be possible for a person to take the necessary steps for personal development and vocational life who suffering from the psychological difficulties. In this respect, beside the vocational advantages and skill advantages of Emek Project, psycho-social support have to be provided to the young people.

Educator: Mustafa ÞÝMÞEK (Industrial Engineer) THE LIFE WHICH IS DECODED

You don't know from where or how to start to it, life covers you completely and you are confused to do something. You always try to find a remedy or solution for this. You are always dragged not taking into consideration your identity. It doesn't matter that you are maybe from Van, Aðrý, Siirt, Bitlis, Þýrnak, Konya, Ankara or Edirne. You witness tens or hundreds of those lives everyday which actually haven't been existed. They are excessive such as the fish in the sea and ants on the earth. They are unemployed, poor and destitute.

I couldn't count how many times I have seen them. I witnessed again because of Bahak foundation. They were living in the city but it seemed that as the city had left them. The foundation had reached to those people. It had reached them with a project which taught reading-writing course, vocational education and democratic rights. The main aim was to give the real meaning of the human being and life.

Even of all of the things are not perfect, it is very important to learn the alphabet, reading-writing, take the necessary steps for the vocational life and to be aware of his rights. It was as important as decoding the code of the life. They realized their talents and strength their self-confidence. They were more powerful than before any more, they were able to overcome the difficulties and problems. They expressed their thoughts like this. They danced between the breaks and meal breaks and their signs were the sign of affection for life.

All of them were Müjde, Selim, Süleyman and Þadiye... they asked questions to themselves and to life, they produced solutions. They learned more things related to the life. They shout out to the world saying that we are here.

Babak Foundation is executing the most necessary and delayed things as taking into consideration those calls. It knows that the not the big words will save the world and the human being, but the small efforts. I saw that they are changed. And they are changed to change their lives and the world.

Educator : Binnaz DEMÝRCAN (Reading-Writing Educator)

The 1st period of reading-writing activities began with 9 students. Three out of them were able to know the alphabet but they had problems to unite the letters and form the correct sentences. A quick reading-writing activity was carried out with those students. They gained reading-writing skills in a short time. They were made to read a book (from World Children Classics) for each week to get reading habits. They developed their skills and were able write anything what they told. The basic math lessons were given also. They had been the good readers at the end of the term (4 months).

After the reading-writing studies (3 months) carried out with the other six persons, they started to read the sentences as syllabicating. They improved their reading-writing skills by the end of the term. They were able to read and write the numbers.

They didn't want that the course be finished. They would like to continue to reading-writing course also during the 2nd term, but it was impossible.

The 2nd Group reading-writing course started with 9 students. This group was slightly different that the others. There were some young people who haven't even touched the pencil. During the first day, I thought that a student, who was hardly speaking, wouldn't be able to learn reading-writing in this short time. But they amazed me. They were so diligent and determined. They learnt reading-writing in a month. They developed their reading skills and read many of the books.

There were some students among them who weren't able to count the numbers and to phone somebody. They learned numbers after getting reading-writing skills. The student, whom I thought that he could not learn reading, also learned phoning after learning the numbers.

I enjoyed the studies I carried out with the young people who hadn't any chance to go to school due to lack of facilities. They were clever. They were open to learning process. They were able to absorb quickly any information they got and they were demanding more knowledge than before. But the time was too short.

I think that "If those young people had the appropriate education-training chance, their lives would be more different than this." So I would like to be sure that every children have school education.

Educator : Eylem DAĐDEVÝREN (Computor Educator)

Information era is one of the biggest changing and transformation era of the human being. As covering the changing facility of this era in which we also live, we should use the technological tools such as computers e.t.c to make the development easier than before and to search remedies for various problems. Because such invents have been as a part of our lives and they have eased our works. As taking into consideration all of these, Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation presents computer course at its center. I am the volunteer educator of this course.

I gave computer lessons during the two periods of Emek project. Friends (students) those who attended to the course and who haven't met with a computer before, showed timidity and attitudes with lack of confidence when seeing a computer as the first time. They were afraid to break the computer down if they touch it and weren't sure to be able to use the

computers. But day by day as the lessons proceeded, they knew that they also could use the computers by themselves and they also understood the usage of the computers are not so difficult. And also this was the result because of their self-confidence. All of those observations are so important from my point of view. Because knowing of their awareness related to their talents, revealing of their potentials and diverting their lives are so important points. I will be very happy, if I could have helped them and made some contributions to their lives. People can be more happy and confident if they share the information to each other. I also experienced such feelings because of students of the Project.

Educator : Erol HINC (Personal Development Lesson)

The desire of the friends (students) related to the studies made me really happy during the first week of Emek Project. Everybody was trying to show and prove himself/herself during the meeting. But a few students were trying to hide him as doing nothing at this meeting. I realized during the second week that they are insufficient applying the main terms (tolerance, feedback, cooperation) for being a group which they had learn at the first week. As if they were seemed that they had forgotten all of the things they had learned at the last week. I interpreted this situation as they were meeting such a word first time. Beside this negative situation, some of the students who have changed themselves positively in a couple weeks and got the importance of these studies, made me very happy. After the third week, I got the results of the studies. I believe that we have done a good job when seeing the students who devoted themselves to self-improvement even during the single lessons of the week. From that day, all of the members of the group were attending to the studies in joy. Nobody were telling "That is not my business" when coming across with a problem and the members of the group were acting more critical than before and they were aware of their responsibilities in the group. Even the lessons are 2 hours, students are demanding more and more working. They said that they were taking the advantages of these lessons at their own lives. That is, the studies were helping them and reaching the aim.

But also the negative results were being obtained because of not being familiar with the group and some of the heavy home works for them. The negative critique (negative feedback) was the best sample for this. I demanded from the students to play the game which was related to saying of the negative sides of the group members. The aim of the game was development of the group members by criticizing each other. In this way, each member of the group would watch his/her behaviors. But upon the misunderstanding of the concept of this game, some of the disputes happened in the group, we decided to progress this study only with the positive criticism. By this way, the studies continued without any disorganization problems.

I observed that the students were very sad at the last session of the studies upon finishing of the studies and they were insisting for continuation of the studies and it was the sign of their efforts and desire for developing themselves. I would like to thank to the workers of Emek Project who have shown their great efforts during the studies.

Educator: Hasbiye GÜNAÇTI (Specialist Nurse) Being illiterate is the dark side of the life.

There were two indefinite issues: Who were these students? And How would I give the lectures?; when they told me that I would give the lectures such as Sexual Health (The Genital Anatomy of Women and Men), Practical

First Aid, Environmental Health and Nutrition at Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation. It is very difficult to give lectures to a group whose demand for learning, education level and their social atmosphere are not familiar for you yet. Even, one of the most important topics which I would give lectures about it which was ignored and counted as a taboo in the society.

There were 3 men among the students, we thought if we should divide the group as two other separate groups as men and women while teaching such topics and I gave the sexual health lectures to only women group (Anatomy of Women Genital Organs).

The women students listened to the lecture with all ears... They carefully looked at the drawings on the board and in the books... At the end of the lecture, they started to talk about the true things which they have misunderstood till that day. Almost everybody had interested in the lecture and expressed that they have obtained such information related to those issues. They needed to get information about the things which were described as "Shame-Forbidden" in the society. I decided to give the lectures without any discrimination between the women and men members of the group. Because I had learned the misunderstanding side of the truths related to our prejudices which were such as "we can not give lectures to the students as they are mixed in the class, they will be ashamed, bored or show actions against it"

We broke this misunderstanding together...I have learned that when you give lectures to them as they are present in the class as women and men, they understand this. The students of the Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation taught this to me. They were expressing their thoughts as "Teacher! It is very good for us that you have given lectures about this issues which were accepted as taboos of the society, because of you we learned not to be ashamed and talk these issues"

These young people who were imprisoned to their houses in the compulsory chosen ghettos, have come to Baḥak Cultural and Artistic Foundation, have reminded us that the misunderstanding things are also interpreted as prejudices of the society.. They made me happy by knowing such kind of the people who were really needed to learn somethings about the life.

I believe that 55 people in the group know to apply Practical First Aid successfully. From now on, they won't be such audiences related to events happening in the world. They will not be trouble for the other people because of the sexual taboos...I believe that they are aware of the importance of a clean, noiseless environment for human health. And they will care about the good nutrition instead of filling their stomachs with food...

Knowledge means the light against the dark.

Educator: Dilek ZEYBEK (Consultant For Enterprise and Communication Education)

When I called by phone the valuable person Pahhaným Kanat who is the president of Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation, it was January 2005. They were among the winners of the Project contest which was arranged by Ýpkur in association with EU. They would give education related to qualifying them for textile sector to the groups consisting from young people who had left their original settlements and came to Kayýpdað in Istanbul because of the Compulsory Immigration. I wanted to make some contributions and I would gave the lectures under the titles of "Social"

Communication" and "What Is The Essential Principles For A Person When Searching A Job?"

Actually, I hadn't seen the foundation before and I was not familiar with their studies. I had a prejudice as "Probably that foundation is like the other foundations which only help to their fellow countryman". But when I entered to the building of the foundation I was amazed. There were brilliant young people, a huge hall, sewing machines one after one and cutting machines; I thought that it was completely a professional education place for students. And when Mrs. Pahhaným presented the educational and artistic activities for the children in the region; I was completely fascinated when seeing those activities. A few people have succeeded many big works. That means, nothing is impossible as working voluntarily for NGOs.

I started to the my first lectures after a while. I was a very nice experience for me. When I was trying to teach something to these young people, I was also learning many different things from them. The common feature of the related group, is expressing of themselves as "the real people of the city". They introduce themselves as stating their names and names of their cities. Even some of them are born in Istanbul, they introduces themselves as "from Mardin, Siirt, or Diyarbakýr". Some of them says that they feel themselves as strange people in Istanbul.

They have worked at textile sector as "unqualified" workers who do the little jobs which are not important. All of them say that they would like to be qualified and have a profession. I saw that these educations will help them to get themselves out of the unqualified status of the work.

There were married people among them, even some of them had been married and been mothers while they were so little. As they expressed, they have experienced oppression from their families. Their mothers and fathers were anxious and because of that they were always scolded by their families. As being effected from the subjects of the lectures, they have expressed that the similar structure was passed to them from their families and they have acted to their children as they were treated. The good point is that they are sorry for these attitudes. But they hadn't any idea to get rid of that structure. Even single day education helped them to get awareness.

It will be possible to get rid of those kinds of behaviors disorders by the regular psychological consultation instead of the educations which will last a few days. The psychological support also should have been given to fathers also beside mothers. Because mothers and fathers has problems communicating with each other. Fathers generally leaves the education duty to the mothers and mothers also accept it. But fathers don't get out of the family system by transferring this duty (naturally), they also effect the personal development of the children as passively. The negotiations, educations and consultation have to be given to father and mothers together to construct a healthy family structure. This situation should be constituted for the relations between the wife-husband. Actually, there are very serious communication problems between the members of our society.

The health of the mother-father-child is very important for the general mental health of the society.

They seriously feel the social oppressions from their relatives and friends. Most of them are complaining because of these oppressions from their families and say that they would like to be free individuals. These oppressions are made by mother-in-law, sister-in-law, and father-in-law e.t.c.

I believe that such an education will have permanent effects both for those young people and for us. The studies of such foundations and associations like Bahak Cultural and Artistic Foundation needed to be supported and

widespread. This support is possible by the raising of consciousness and awareness of the society.

I would like to thank from heart to every people who have efforts for realizing of this important project.

Educator: Leyla DOĐAN (Teacher of Music)

It was between ends of the September and beginning of October, My friend Edibe called me and asked me "Leyla, would you like to make contributions for our Emek project? Project participators will realize the activities at the end of December, can you form a chorus among them?", I went to Baþak Foundation to discuss the details. Number of the students were 11 (eleven) for chorus. The first impression I got from those young people who were forced to come to Istanbul was fearful state of them.

We choose the songs which we would sing. We promised to each other to meet at16.00 hours on every Monday. I found them waiting for me in front of the study room or at the door every Monday. As knowing each other day by day, the fearful eyes left their place to the lovely and sincere looks. Due to the universal feature of the music which deeply effects, covers the people and makes relations between them, day by day I realized that they were more social than before and they have gained the self-confidence. Continual studies made them more disciplined than before and consequently they improved trust for me. Our relations returned to a fellowship and confidence relation. They were sincere but not disrespectful against me.

I had assigned the my only spare time at afternoon in the week for this study and also it had kept me away from the other activities which I had to do, but I was very happy when seeing them waiting for me and singing the songs with joy.

I realized that all of them were very excited when they were presenting the activities and studies at the scene for the families, their relatives and guests on evening of 24 December. The time for saying goodbye to each other also had com from these young people who had studies since months. They were sad because of this goodbye for each other and for foundation.

Even it has been a short time, I am very happy to meet and know these students and to make contributions to this Emek Project. As wishing a happy and fruitful future to these young people, I also would like to thank to every people who have contributions to such a good Project and showed great efforts and also would like to thank to these young people who have seen a different place of Istanbul out of their settlement.

Educator Rugeb KIRICI (THEATER ACTRESS)

Actually, their aim wasn't to be stars or artists. They were the only the reluctant heroes of the story which were written without asking them. And they didn't want this anymore. Because they had already realized that they have begun to a new story beginning to this project. And each of them was ready to his/hers own story. Some of them added folklore, some of them added music and some of them added theater to their stories. Actually they forced their creative skills to show their activities to their families and the other people.

Finally they wrote their own stories, specified their roles, and the scene... And they were at scene from now on. They were saying that we act

therefore we are.

They are the volunteer heroes of their own stories from now on... I am very happy to be given a chance to make contributions. I am sure that you would be very excited if you had a chance to see the fast changing at them.

Educator: Derya BOZKURT (Educator For Folk Dances)

I had started as an employee of Emek project. When I realized that the Project is more than a vocational course, I asked to myself "What can I do for them?". I had been employed previously as folk dances educator at the coverage of an NGO. When our coordinator offered that to me, I accepted it with pleasure.

When we began to studies at first time, some of the friends were hesitating to attend the studies and some of them had a big desire for it. They actually had a big desire but they were anxious. There were also some undisciplined behaviors among them.

We began to the first lesson with discussions on folk dances; everybody talked about the dances of their regions and also showed their styles. Upon this, we started to specify the dances which we would perform. Dance, music, figure... We collectively were taking the decisions. This style made the studies easier, and at the same time was bringing the harmony and collective study. This situation was reflected positively to the other vocational courses. When we had some disputes and stress during the daily training, we danced and played horon (a special dance belongs to Black Sea Region)...

Sometimes we embraced the friends with our dances that were receded and said that "I can't achieve this activity". By the time, the number of the participators increased.

Some of them hadn't any scene experience before and they were very excited because of this, but actually it made our job easier. They performed theirs first activity before their families at meetings of boosting the consciousness, I saw them crying of excitement. It was a very nice feeling and this excitement would be the main base for the oncoming performances.

Even though we experienced some technical problems in night of December 24, they did their best with great efforts.

I realized that the Project was supporting these students in terms of vocational education and social meaning, but also the foundation was allocating all of its efforts and artistic activities to reveal and support their talents. I hope they have the other chances to develop these talents.



OPINIONS OF THE STUDENTS (COURSE TAKERS)

We reserved third section of the book to the opinions of the students who have taken the advantages of the Project. The most important thing was their knowledge, observations and experiences. Because they were the ones who have created this project and executed it.

The course evaluations of the students have been made in two ways upon their request. Some of the students wanted to express their opinions in writing, and some of them wanted to express their opinions orally. The opinions of the students, who wanted to express their opinions orally, were recorded. The main reason for record is the necessity for specifying the measures of the evaluations of the Project at a concrete base. The students whose opinions were recorded, have said that they were very excited during the recording process and have forgotten some of their opinions. For that reason, we didn't interfere to the natural flow of this negotiations even they were routine sometimes. We completely and exactly transferred the opinions of the students to the book.

The notice was full of the questions. I thought a while whether to accept or not. 27 persons would be accepted for it. And so many people would apply for it. There was the course of the municipality. I had applied to painting course. The course was free, but we had to buy the materials were on us. But they also can't provide more facilities like here. The main difference is this: All of the education costs are at the warranty of Europe Project. There is lack of opportunity in Turkey. They don't care about young people in Turkey.

There are not many courses for the young people like these. There were some courses during some periods in the past, but I have never taken advantages of such courses. Here is a foundation. This point is very important. I am qualified both for myself and society.

I have seen a program on TV. There were about ten people. They were on contest. They were drawing something. I was interested in during that day. I heard the stylist sector from the TV. My interest was formed during that day. I got familiar with it here.

There is lack of foreign language education and computer education facilities here. But it is very nice to do some nice things here. The facilities are limited but it is also very nice. This

Project could be developed by the technological facilities. Everybody try to do something, but it is not sufficient. I mean the drawings on the computer are very important. There are many computer programs and we can take their advantages. There are many paid private courses which are working with these programs. They can follow the new technologies with these programs. I found the life very nice after getting reading and writing skills. It is very nice. When I heard this project, I felt that it would be very useful for people and I was hopeful about it. I think that the efforts of our teachers will be useful for us at our lives. I am not regretful for coming here. I got a profession here. I will be able to work at a textile factory and earn money. I am able to earn money for school charges of my children and also able to make a living. It is a very nice thought. I am very happy that I have a profession. Our future is illuminated; we found a way to get out of the darkness.

The social education really worked. We learned to claim our rights and learned to be respectful rights of the other people. The social lessons are really nice. It goes well. I would like it be continued for the other friends who will come here after us. I amble to persuade the other people around me because of the social education. I was a very offensive person in the past. But I am changed. I am sol calm and I am able to persuade the other people in a good way.

I knew that this project would be the best for us. Such an atmosphere really

changed us. If I had enough facilities I would come here for voluntarily service. But I don't have such facilities. I would like to thank the teacher for these things. I wish that the teacher have nice activities. The foundation is really a good place which needs more work. Here is such a place which deserves more support. GÜLCAN AYDIN

Unemployed

I have been in Ýstanbul since 12 13 years. The main reason for being in Ýstanbul is the immigration. I was illiterate. There was school in the village. I continued 1 year and the school was closed. I couldn't continue my education. I started to work at textile sector at my age of 11. I worked for 10 years at textile sector. The only aim working at textile sector was earning money for making a living. I was working during 24 hours of the

day. I heard here. I knew here before, but I had no idea about coming here. My older brothers wanted me to come here. I didn't want. I went to another place in the past. It didn't realize because of the lack of reading and writing skills. I came here to get reading and writing skills. Then I saw that I can read here. My older brothers, sisters and sister-in-law were able to read newspapers and books. It was a very difficult situation for me. I had never read a newspaper or book. I can read a little bit, but I believe that I will develop myself. It was really difficult for me in the past. I couldn't go anywhere, because I was illiterate. I couldn't establish friendship in the past. I still can't establish friendship, but I believe that I will correct it soon. In the past, I didn't believe that I would learn reading/writing.

It was very difficult not to be able to read or write at the workshops. I was always scolded for this problem and I was crying because of that problem. It was so bad. I had no position in the life. I can read some writings on the street. But I have to develop my reading and writing. I think that I will be able to express myself after I can manage reading and writing skills.

I have spare time now. I have been learning many good things here. I have experienced many things because of this project. Maybe I can't express it, but my friendship atmosphere is really changed. I established warm friendships. I changed my attitude against my family. I had many mistakes but corrected them here. I also had no time for them. But everything is so changed. Myself self-confidence is back again.. I had a promise to my older brother to be able to read the newspaper in the future and he also urges me to read the newspaper. I have also experienced many changes on me. I had no expectation for myself.

Especially being literate is more important than having a job. Reading and writing is a very nice activity for me and also the evaluation meetings on Friday were also important for me. Especially the people like Mrs. Þahhaným, Teacher Cafer really helped us... The job is actually not very important for me. I spent 1213 years but it gave me nothing. I met many nice people here. It is more important than the other events. The social education is also great. I also would like to say that I worked many years but nobody provided insurance for me. But I believe that I can make me insured at the workshops from now on.

I would like to express myself not only in terms of the job but also for social reasons. I was illiterate in the past. I was always working. I began at 8.30 in the morning and finished at 3 -4 of the night. I was working also on Saturday and Sunday. We had a limited time to rest at park only. But everything is changed. Thanks to God that I have come here. As I told you before, I actually didn't want to come here. I came here to learn reading and writing. The foundation appreciates the people. The problems are shared here. You always have the friends to share your problems with. It is a very nice thing. The foundation appreciates people and gives the selfconfidence. Thanks.



REMZÝYE YILDIZ

They 12 siblings Unemployed

It has been 3 years since I am in Ýstanbul. I was always at home. My life was continuing at home. I came here and learned sewing and usage of the machine. I learned reading/writing here. I am not bored any more since I come here. I was always bored at home. I felt myself as a useless person in the past.

I was very pessimistic before starting to reading and writing. I couldn't go to anywhere without any knowledge. I even couldn't go to shopping. I didn't know the numbers and services. I always felt myself as ignorant. I hadn't any knowledge about the life. I was ashamed before the other people. I was really pessimistic about the future. I thought myself as useless. But it is ok now. I was in depression but I feel myself relieved.

Everything is changed for me after learning of reading and writing. I couldn't go anywhere due to lack of illiterate position. I had no self-confidence. And I will be an employee who is able to use the machine in the future, but I will scold nobody. Because I know this feeling. I will do my best for the people who will work for me. I will be able to manage myself also. Many textile factories are established here. I will apply to them as a mechanic in the future. I will work and my life will change. From now on, everything is changed

I am very satisfied from this Project and I want it to be continued. I have many friends here. They are so kindhearted. I like everybody here such as Mrs. Pahhaným and the others. It is a pleasure for me knowing and coming to the foundation. I like Mrs. Þahhaným.

Now I can myself better than before and I also feel myself better. In the past, I was humiliated by the other people when I was telling them that I was illiterate. But I am very comfortable because I am literate now.

Having a profession is very nice for me... I will be able to earn money without being in need of the helps of the other people. It is very important. I will depend on myself. It was really difficult for me. I came here to be a modelist when I heard the project. This thought makes me relieved, but I don't know whether I have self-confidence or not. From now on, I will search the job as a modelist, it makes me relieved. I depend on myself.

I can say that the social education didn't mean much thing for me. I have been to such kind of the social education lessons in the past. It is not a new thing for me. It really changed me. We also take the social education here. But the friends who come here should break the walls around their brain and should be ready a little bit to change themselves. The social education being given now couldn't create an effect on me. The social education which was given before was based on the memorizing system. There should have been much different things.

The education should have been also about the other cultures and religions. For example we are Kurds, What do we think about Armenian people? There should have been a discussion platform. I should have known these. I should have caught the details. Such a Project should be done. Many of the friends haven't go out of their houses. But they come here and develop themselves. They get self-confidence here. Such projects should be continued. There were many courses at the coverage of the NGOs. NGOs are so ideological and they have a narrow point of view. BSV (Baþak Cultural and Artistic Foundation) gives importance to social education. I believe that the foundation will take better results. There will be many deficiencies of here also. But here is so fruitful than the other places. I am comfortable here.
